**UNENCLOSED SIDEWALK CAFÉ PERMIT**

*Pursuant to the approval by the Public Space Committee (PSC) on December 15, 2006, permission is given to Federal Center Hotel, on behalf of Starbucks, subject to the conditions of this approval and to all applicable provisions of Title 24 DCMR, Chapters 2 and 3, to maintain and use a portion of the public right-of-way for a Sidewalk Café adjacent to its premises located at 550 C St., SW. Said sidewalk café area will be fourteen (14) ft in width and seventeen (17) ft in length, for a total of two hundred thirty-eight (238) sq ft, contain 4 tables and 12 chairs, and allow ten (10) ft of clear and unobstructed space for pedestrians at all times along 6<sup>th</sup> Street, NW.*

**Hours of Operation:** 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sun.-Thurs./ 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Fri.-Sat.  
**Year round.**

**Compensation:** \$260 one time permit fee; \$260 annual Certificate of Use fee, and \$1,190 annual rent (\$5.00 per sq ft)

- This permit is revocable by the District Department of Transportation or the Metropolitan Police Department at any time.
- The permit holder will maintain the café area free of trash and debris at all times and maintain the café furnishings in good condition.
- No logos, insignias or advertising of any kind will be displayed in the public space.
- No café operating material will be placed in the public space earlier than ½ hour before opening the café and all such material must be removed within ½ hour of closing the café.
- No café furnishings can extend beyond the boundaries of the approved café.
- All café furnishings must be stored on private space when the café is not in operation.
- No deviation from the approved plan is allowed without prior permission from the PSC.
- The use of the public space to establish and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café shall conform to all applicable District statutes and regulations.
- The permit holder will secure a Certificate of Use from the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs within six (6) month of the date of this permit.
- The permit holder will maintain at all times insurance to the sole benefit of the District of Columbia as required.

*A copy of this permit must be displayed prominently in public view, adjacent to any other licenses and permits that are required by the District of Columbia to be publicly displayed. A copy of the approved site plan and current Certificate of Use must be on site at all times.*
